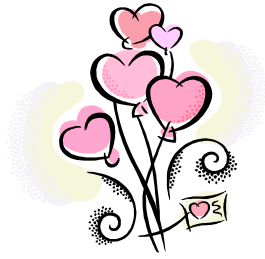
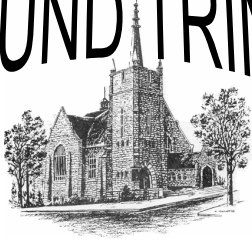

HIGHLIGHTS OF FEBRUARY 3, 2009 COUNCIL MEETING

- research being done on insurance costs and Trinity's Heritage designation contract
- a motion will be taken to the Feb. 8th Annual Meeting recommending that Trinity "continues discussions with Westminster with the intention of possible future amalgamation"
- **Shane Judge** will be the Master of Ceremonies for the February 21 Evening of Entertainment which will see participation from each of the five North Ward United Churches
- Council gave support for the Relay for Shelter and will make the opportunity available for one or more people to participate
- Presbytery's Winter Meetings are being hosted by Trinity and lots of volunteers required. Additional people are also needed in the Sunday School on Presbytery Sunday as other congregations will be attending.
- **Les Mayes**, Treasurer, reported that expenditures exceeded revenue at the end of January by \$10,778.50. PAR is currently bringing in \$7,113.50 a month and Memorial Fund stands at \$8,986.31. Council also recommending that the proposed 2009 budget be taken to the Annual Meeting for approval.
- **Jean Murray** of Property reported that the washrooms were painted, the motor on the heating system replaced at a cost of \$450, and the leak on the elbow of the pipe outside the men's choir room is to be fixed
- letter sent requesting increase in telephone book delivery (presently is 35¢ per book)
- **Al Houstoun** has posted the 'how to do it' origami instructions on the website along with other children's information. Presbytery information also on line.
- a Trinity 101 box will be prepared for the Sunday bulletins by Randy to provide details about the life of our church
- Trinity and Westminster Worship Committees met recently and plan to share in some of the Lenten activities
- holding summer services in one location with Trinity, St. Paul and Westminster taking part is being investigated
- the Sounds of Superior Concert netted a profit of \$785.00
- **Norma Foley** and **Carolyn Enns** will be going off Council in 2009 and the Chair extended thanks and appreciation to them for their participation. **Paula Leach** and **Bob Foley**, Presbytery reps, will be going off Council in June.
